# Learning together

- We want you to be able to work together as a family to get the most out of your iPad.
- We want you to feel you are in control and comfortable with the technology.
- We have developed video tutorials to help with the set up. These are preloaded onto the iPad. Parents have also been sent an email with a link to the videos.
- Look through them together so that you and your child feel confident when using it.

# When you get home:

- The videos you will need to access are on the home screen called iPad videos. They are numbered 1,2,3.
- The first video shows how to assign yourself as a student. This allows you to receive all of the School's prepaid Apps at absolutely no cost to you and allows us to give you resources that you will need to make progress.
- The second video helps you setup your school e-mail on your device. This allows us to send you important information. You will also receive a handout of step by step instructions.
- The third video shows you how to setup an Apple ID. This is necessary if you want to download Apps yourself and create backups of your iPad data. You can setup a free or paid account. This guide shows you how to setup a free account.
