Works commenced on-site 27th October 2025

The formation of a new temporary access road off the A41 is complete and in use.

Section 1 - Construction of new school building

- Works progressing well, site strip substantially complete, forming temporary haulage roads and Engineered working platforms on-site nearing completion .
- New drainage commenced.
- · Excavating and concreting foundations ongoing.
- Diversion of existing water main complete.

Section 1 - Key future activities.

- Steel erection to commence February 2026.
- Installation of Pre Cast Concrete planks and lift shaft.
