Homelessness Review Consultation – Cheshire West and Chester Council

Cheshire West and Chester Council is carrying out a review of the levels of homelessness and the services available to homeless people across the area. The findings from the review will be used to develop a new homelessness strategy.

The Council believes a partnership approach is fundamental to tackling and effectively preventing homelessness, and we would like to hear your views to help us improve the service we offer to our service users and stakeholders.

We would also like to hear from service users and a link to the customer survey has been emailed out to a large number of people who have contacted the Council's Housing Options service for advice on housing, homelessness, or to make a homeless application. In addition to the surveys we have also developed a one-question postcard. The postcard is a quick way of letting us know what you think would solve homelessness in our area. You can access the postcard via [HomelessnessPostcard](#) but printed copies will also be available in a number of locations across the borough (e.g. Hamilton House, Victoria House, council offices, libraries) so that anyone can write down their views and post it in the box provided.
