## **SIXTH FORM STUDENT LEARNING CONTRACT**

Upton-by-Chester High School is a popular, success and oversubscribed school and there is strong competition for places. Given this situation and the traditionally high expectations with regard to attitude and behaviour within the Sixth Form, it is vital that the following contract is carefully considered by entrants and their parents/carers.

Students in the Sixth Form are required to aim high, think positively, communicate collectively, work hard and develop their skills and talents within our school ethos of respect.

Please do not sign the contract unless you are happy to be bound by it and be aware that if you fail to meet the stated conditions, then you may well be asked to leave the Sixth Form.

### **PART 1**

#### **The school agrees to support students in their aspirations for continuing education and work:**

- by providing a curriculum that reflects the needs of post-16 students
- by providing quality teaching and tutorial support
- by regular and continuing process of consultation and monitoring with appropriate feedback
- by providing a range of guidance and information services and opportunities
- by ensuring that students are fully aware of the standards of work and conduct expected of them
- by providing accurate and informative references; this is a prerequisite for employers and higher education/university courses.

### **PART 2**

#### **The student agrees to contribute to their own learning**

- by 100% attendance at all lessons including PLaN sessions, assemblies and presentations by guest speakers. Home study is a privilege only awarded to Upper Sixth students based on a successful progress review (after October half-term)
- by high standards of punctuality. Students must sign in within the allotted time frame, be punctual to all lessons and to Plan with their tutor. Persistent lateness will result in after school detentions
- by not taking driving lessons during timetabled lessons, registration or assembly time
- by providing written notice or explanation of absence from parents/carers on return (section in student planner provided). Holidays should not be taken during term time
- by dressing sensibly in accordance with the dress code (see handbook)
- by completing homework/coursework to the best of their ability within set deadlines

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- by arriving at lessons fully prepared and equipped. Students must catch up on any work missed due to absence and so forth
- by endeavouring to be involved in a range of activities beyond their academic studies e.g. Hall activities, music, sport, drama, charity work
- by following the protocol and procedures regarding the use of identity passes, mobile phones, the school's 'no smoking' policy, signing in and out during the school day and use of the International Learning Hub
- by responsible and sensible standards of behaviour in respect of other members of the school and wider community and in the use of the facilities of the Sixth Form Centre.
