5. Peter Brook

Learners participate in the creation, development and performance of **two** pieces of live theatre, based on **one** of the above mentioned stimuli:

- **One** devised piece using the working methods and techniques of **either** an influential theatre practitioner **or** a recognized theatre company
- One extract from a text in a different style to the devised piece.

Learners realise their performances live for the visiting examiner.

Learners choosing design must also give a **5-10 minute** presentation of their design to the examiner. Learners produce one process and evaluation report on both pieces within **one** week of the completion of the practical work.
