I hope that you and your family are keeping safe. I just wanted to write to you in what will probably be the first of a weekly communication designed to keep you up to date with any developments and make sure, that as a school community, we are able to support each other through these challenging times.

I firstly want to thank you all for your support to date. It really has been appreciated. Please keep in touch with us using the admin@uptonhigh.co.uk email address. This is monitored each day. We are also answering telephone calls via the main office as normal. Please also make use of the school website which has lots us useful information on it that will support you and your child during this period of time. Critical Worker Provision

The school has started this week to deliver the provision of educational support for priority learners and those with parents who are classified as 'critical workers'. We have had a number of learners in school today, supervised by staff. This provision will be open throughout the period of 'lockdown'. If you feel your child is eligible for this provision please email dorans@uptonhigh.co.uk. I must continue to emphasise that this provision should only be used if there is no safe alternative.

All parents who are registered for the provision will receive an email by 5pm on a Thursday asking you to indicate the days you require support for your child in the following week. If this could please be completed by 3pm on the Friday it will allow us to ensure we have appropriate staffing numbers in place.

Our understanding, at this point in time, is that school transport will continue to operate. As we get further clarification on this we will share this with you.

We are able to offer a hot meal provision on site this week and will inform you of the arrangements for future weeks as soon as we are aware from our providers.

Remote Learning

As you will be aware we are using Google Classrooms to deliver our online learning. This is the same platform as during the summer and also the same tool that is used to set homework in the school.

If your child does not have access to a device please contact the school on admin@uptonhigh.co.uk and we will look to provide you with a device for the period of the current lockdown.

Whilst I appreciate that this is very concerning for learners in Year 11 and Year 13 I can assure you that we will do everything we can to support learners during this period of time. My view is that the government will now explore other ways of assessing each learner's attainment and for this reason it is essential that learners remain engaged with their learning throughout this period of lock down and when we return to school.

I will be writing to Year 11 and year 13 learners separately today and I can assure you that as soon as we have more information we will contact you.

Year Eight Parents Evening.

The Year Eight Parents' evening will continue as planned. Please find below a reminder of the information sent out to parents prior to the Christmas break.
