Welcome to my last letter of the academic year and apologies it has arrived after term has ended. We have had such a busy end to the year that my letter took longer than expected!

The term has ended with a succession of activities including;

- Year 8 being involved in two days of Performance Workshops to develop their performance skills and confidence.
- 82 Year 10 learners completing their DoE Bronze Award expedition.
- A food bank collection which sent 50+ boxes of food to West Cheshire food bank.
- A group of Year 13 learners completing their DoE Gold Award expedition.
