British Cycling Female Endurance Talent Identification



Dear Parent/Guardian

I am getting in touch to make you aware of a Female Talent Identification Programme for Cycling we are running this year. Which hopes to identify the cycling potential of talented young people from across England, with those successful going on to join British Cycling's Talent Development and Performance Pathways. Please find more details of this opportunity below and how to get involved.

This could be the start of a journey that could lead to potentially going to the Olympic games and following in the footsteps of British Olympic medalists Dame Laura Kenny, Katie Archibald, Elinor Barker and Neah Evans.

If your child would like to get more involved in this Talent ID Program and the sport of cycling. Then please complete the below application form which can be opened by scanning the QR code below with your mobile phone camera. Applications will close on **Friday 28**th **April 2023**.

Following completing an application your child could be invited to one of our 3 testing days taking place across England throughout May and June. Each testing day will typically broken down into 3 parts; a workshop delivered by coaches from the Great Britain Cycling Team explaining the cycling pathway and the exiting journey riders could go on, a number of physical test using Wattbikes and off the bike tests for a chance to show us what you can do!

- Manchester Sunday 14th May 2023
- Derby Monday 29th May 2023
- London Sunday 11th June 2023

You must be born in the years 2008 and 2009 to apply and be eligible for a British passport, but no prior racing experience is required – just the ability to ride a bike!
