## <u>Scopay</u>

The provider for Scopay have informed us of the following functionality issues for users to be aware of when using Scopay:

- In order to set up and connect a debit or credit card to the **Monthly Billing** function, you must use a card that has previously been saved for payments.
- The amount of cashless catering credit that you set within Monthly Billing as a Target Balance will be applied to <u>all</u> school users in your account, so if you set an amount of £10 under one child's name it will also be applied to any linked siblings' accounts, meaning that if you have 3 children in your account, it will charge whatever amount is required to bring each of your 3 children's balance up to £10 each month.
- The **Request Refund** button seen under Aspens Cashless Catering is <u>not active</u> and unfortunately the button cannot be removed from Scopay. Aspens will not respond to any refund requests made in this way, so if you do require a refund, please contact the school by email to <u>finance@uptonhigh.co.uk</u> providing all relevant details.
