# **Update from the Headteacher**

Dear Parents and carers,

As we reach the end of this current half term I just wanted to take a moment to reflect on the achievements of our young people. I cannot believe the number of activities / events that they have been involved in. These have ranged from sporting to cultural, drama and art activities. I am really looking forward to this term's Upton Voice which will showcase all areas of school life.

During this half term we have been able to welcome an incredible number of parents and carers into the school for open evenings and information evenings. We are determined to make sure that we have many more opportunities throughout the year for the community including parents and carers to come into school and see the great work that is going on.

This week we have also received the Progress 8 figures for the school. Progress 8 measures the progress that learners make between the end of KS2 and their GCSE examinations. Over the last two years we have achieved the highest Progress 8 figures that the school has ever achieved and this year it was significant, indicating that learners in the school achieved half a GCSE grade more in every subject than the national average progress. We are very proud of this and will continue to work to ensure every young person in the school makes outstanding progress.

At the beginning of next term, we have an INSET day on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October. This means that learners return to school on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October. 

# **Social Media Safety**

The online world is an essential part of our daily lives and learning how to use technology safely is an essential skill for young people. Apps such as Tiktok and Whatsapp, for example, are extremely popular but risks are posed and it is important that schools, parents and carers work together to take an active role in teaching children about online dangers. Learning how to act safely when using the internet is an incredibly important part of safeguarding our children and your role as a parent/carer can make a significant difference.

It is vitally important that parents and carers check which social media groups their children are joining. Learners have been taught in school not to join open groups, for example Whatsapp and Tiktok, and give away personal details including images which show their school uniform or other personal information. Disagreements between children on social media can have a negative impact on their wellbeing whilst taking up a great deal of valuable time for staff in school.
