#### **KEY INFORMATION FOR YEAR 12**

##### **DATE AND TIME:**

- *The new school term begins on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2018.***

##### **WHERE TO ASSEMBLE:**

- If you arrive early please go to the Sixth Form Common Room opposite D Block.
- Please go to the **Dining Room** for a short introduction and you will be assigned to your **Lower Sixth Tutor Group**.
- A large proportion of the morning will be an extended tutor period, which will focus on meeting your tutor, life in the Sixth Form and general administration, including receiving your timetable.

##### **DRESS CODE:**

In the Sixth Form you are given the flexibility to wear your own clothes. Standards of dress and appearance should be appropriate for the business of studying and should not include styles which are extreme. Low cut tops and clothes that expose underwear should not be worn. Shirts and shorts should be of a respectable length. Tattoos should not be visible. Dress for more formal occasions (Awards Day, Open Evening, etc.) must be appropriate. If you fail to meet these standards, you may be asked to go home and change.

If you are uncertain, please ask a member of the Sixth Form team.

##### **EQUIPMENT:**

You are expected to come to school equipped for your lessons. Please ensure you have:

- **A4 folders**
- **Writing equipment**
- **File pad (A4 paper).**

##### **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

You are allowed to bring your own tablet device into school. As we operate a managed wi fi solution on site, we have in place structured capacity to allow external devices internet connectivity. Users wishing to connect their device to the network should seek advice from ICT Support or the Learning Hub. Please be aware that wireless access is granted on tablet devices only; mobile or smartphones are not permitted access to the network.

- The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to property, therefore we advise parents to obtain their own insurance cover as the school does not provide cover.
- Sixth Form students are required to read and sign the Students ICT Acceptable usage policy and adhere to the terms set out. Inappropriate usage of the internet/devices will not be tolerated and will be dealt with by the Head of Sixth Form and/or Head teacher.
